A CONTRACT WITH JORDAN JONES & GOULDING, INC. FOR CONSULTING ENGINEERING
SERVICES FOR THE ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESMENT DESIGN OF THE JOHNSON FERRY –
GLENRIDGE – EARMARK PROJECT (T-0011) FOR THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, FULTON
COUNTY, GEORGIA**

WHEREAS, it is necessary, from time to time, to establish policies, procedures and guidelines consistent with the administration of a municipal government consistent with the US Constitution, Federal Statutes, alignment with Federal, Georgia’s State Constitution, and the Charter for the City of Sandy Springs, and

WHEREAS, the City Manager directed the Department of Public Works to develop standard policies for recurring matters, to establish appropriate internal controls and legal compliance, and to provide for an efficient and effective means to serve constituents; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works, in response to the guidance provided by the City Manager, has negotiated and recommends the City Manager signing a contract with Jordan Jones & Goulding, Inc., and

WHEREAS, upon adoption of this Resolution, City Sandy Springs Public Works Department staff will manage all applicable phases of the Consultant Contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA

That the City of Sandy Springs City Council and the Mayor receive, accept, and affirm the authorization for the City Manager to execute a Consultant Contract with Jordan Jones & Goulding, Inc., for the completion of an environmental assessment for the transportation improvement project along Johnson Ferry Road.
