A RESOLUTION CREATING A COMMITTEE TO STUDY AND RECOMMEND A SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PROGRAM INCORPORATING THE NEEDS OF THE RESIDENTIAL AND BUSINESS COMMUNITIES SERVED WITHIN THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the City of Sandy Springs is committed to maintaining legal compliance for regulated industries, such as solid waste collection and disposal; and

WHEREAS, the City is interested in obtaining input from consumers of services to best identify the needs of constituents; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Mayor and City Council to implement a comprehensive solid waste plan; and

WHEREAS, a committee comprised of community volunteers, staff, and businesses will be formed to complete this review in coordination with the City Manager's Office.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THIS COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA, AND IT IS RESOLVED BY THE AUTHORITY OF SAID CITY COUNCIL.

By passage of this resolution, the City of Sandy Springs Mayor and City Council supports the creation of a committee to study and recommend a solid waste management program incorporating the residential and business community's needs and legal compliance in coordination with the City Manager's Office.
