

PUBLIC SAFETY

SSPD

North District

- A suspect is in custody related to a Loitering/Prowling case being worked by Sandy Springs Police. Officer McCabe located a person matching the description of someone who had been seen going through a vehicle at 1155 Mt. Vernon Highway by a witness. The suspect gave a false name, but was soon identified as being wanted by Atlanta PD. It is possible the suspect is responsible for another case.
- An investigation continues related to a shooting at Ecco 400. The unknown suspects knocked on victim's door. With no response at the door, the suspects went to the back of the apartment and shot at least 10 times through the kitchen window. Some of the rounds went through one unit and into another, which was occupied. No injuries were reported. The cause is possibly drug related.
- The owner of the Samad Grill on Roswell Road arrived to open for the day, discovering that someone had thrown a brick through the front glass door. A review of the business' surveillance footage revealed that the suspect was the same person the owner had reported to police the day before for refusing to leave the premise. Approximately \$100 cash was taken from the store.
- Burglary-Business-Force: 1155 Mt. Vernon Hwy (Sports Authority), The on-duty security guard at the Sports Authority on Mt. Vernon observed three black men in a Tan F-150 drive to the front of the store, throw a rock through the window of the business, and then remove an armful of clothing. The security guard was unable to provide a tag number or a better description of the suspects.
- Burglary: 8347 Roswell Rd, Metro PCS - Witness advised SSPD that four to five suspects shattered the glass door of the Metro PCA store and entered the building. Several electronics were stolen from the store. The suspects fled in a gray or silver Dodge Charger. An officer driving an unmarked vehicle spotted the vehicle, which fled at a high rate of speed towards Cobb County.
- A guest at the Hyatt Hotel on Crestline Parkway reported that her car was broken into, with items taken.
- Robbery, Spring Creek Lane: Two suspects entered an apartment on Spring Creek Lane under false pretenses, pointed handguns at the residents inside, and stole an I Pad, iPhone, Galaxy Cell, debit/visa car, \$200.00 cash, and marijuana.
- Community Officer Godfrey assisted with Active Shooter Training and a Property Security Assessment with Surgical Associates of Atlanta.
- Officer Godfrey met with staff at Woodland Elementary, Spalding Drive Elementary and Ison Elementary to introduce himself as a new community officer and share contact information.

South District

- Sergeant Bohannon, Captain Rose, and Sgt. Levy met with risk management and security staff at the three hospitals in the medical district regarding managing incidents affecting traffic access to hospital areas, as a follow to the recent gas leak at Lake Hearn and Peachtree Dunwoody Road. SSPD and security staff from Northside Hospital, St. Joseph's/Emory Hospital, and Children's Healthcare of Atlanta, will convene later this month to finalize plans.
- Officer Begeal completed the Senior Crime Reduction Awareness Measures training program. Brochures are being produced for all of the senior and assisted-living communities in the district.

- Officer Begeal, lead advisor for our Police Explorer Post 59, will be the coordinator for the annual National Explorer Conference in Gatlinburg, TN in February. SSPD will send two teams to this year's competition. Last year's team won several trophies.

Street Crimes Unit

- The Unit made two misdemeanor arrests; six city arrests; and completed 23 traffic stops. There were five cases cleared; two hours spent assisting other units and two hours spent assisting other agencies.
- A stop involving a suspicious person resulted in two arrests: one a person wanted, and one arrest on traffic charges.
- Three suspicious females were located in parking deck at the Concourse. The three were arrested after two gave officers false names, and the third determined to be wanted by authorities.
- The Unit assisted CID with a fraud investigation.

Special Investigations Unit (SIU)

- The Unit made six city arrests; worked 11 drug complaints; and completed seven hours on surveillance. Three knock and talks were conducted; four cases cleared; and 4.8 grams marijuana and .5 gram of meth seized.
- A Knock and Talk conducted at an extended stay hotel resulted in the arrest of one person on marijuana charges.

Traffic Unit

- The Unit conducted three misdemeanor arrests; one city arrest and 83 traffic stops. There were 80 citations issued; one wanted person; and the K9 conducted one track. The Unit spent 22 hours on traffic complaints; issued one search warrant; and opened six new cases. There were two cases cleared, and the Unit spent 32 hours assisting other units.
- DUI units issued three DUIs; 20 moving violations; and five non-moving violations.
- The Unit had SWAT training and Recon in-service training.
- The Unit assisted SIU with a prostitution detail and assisted patrol with a K9 track.

Criminal Investigations Division

- The investigation continues into an unidentified female who passed a forged check at the Sun Trust Bank on Roswell Road. Her accomplice has a history of passing forged checks.
- An unidentified male hailed a cab, took a ride, and then attempted to rob the taxi driver once they reached their destination. The suspect pistol-whipped the victim, who was treated and released from the hospital with non-life threatening injuries. The investigation is ongoing.
- A dispute between a taxi driver and his customer resulted in accusations that the driver took off with the victim halfway out of the cab. The victim was not seriously injured.
- One suspect was identified in connection with a felony shoplifting at Target. SSPD is working with NY State Police on the case.
- SSPD was able to get one of the suspects of the thefts from RBM, Classic Collision and Classic Cadillac identified with warrants obtained for his arrest for 29 counts of entering auto, three counts of criminal trespass, and one count of felony theft.
- SSPD is working with Kroger to obtain video of a female suspect who is believed to be stealing activated Kroger gift cards.
- A 15-year-old juvenile is a person of interest in connection with a burglary in the 8800 block of Roswell Road. The juvenile was kicked out the store the day before the burglary. SSPD is working on obtaining video evidence.

Community Affairs

- Sergeant Momon attended a Media and Public Relations class held by FBI-LEEDA.
- Chief DeSimone attended the Georgia FBI NAA Winter Business Meeting.

- High demand for gun safety classes continues. Classes are full through April. The May class is 50 percent full.

Volunteers

- The Citizens on Patrol Unit worked 231 hours and conducted 24 shifts this past week.
- They conducted 25 house checks and issued 28 handicap-parking citations.
- A total of 1,002 total miles were covered with the majority of that time focused on residential and target areas. The Unit is working on a project for Public Works, checking and identifying streetlights, which may be out of order.

SSFR

Operations:

- Responded to a total of 232 calls: five Fires, 107 EMS calls, 25 Service Calls, 64 Good Intent Calls, 25 False Alarms
- Crews responded to reports of the smell of natural gas at the intersection of Johnson Ferry and Peachtree Dunwoody Roads. They discovered the odor was coming from a pressure relief valve at the intersection. The valve was not actively leaking when personnel arrived, nor was any smell or odor noticeable. Crews requested Atlanta Gas to respond to the scene and check the valve as a precaution.
- Crews responded to a cooking fire at the 4000 block of Lafayette Court. Atlanta Fire arrived on call and entered the home to assist. The fire was confined to the stove, and personnel assisted with ventilation. The stove door had locked itself shut, causing the interior to burn. Crews cut off the gas and power going to the stove.
- Crews responded to a non-emergency call, which was upgraded upon information regarding water pouring out of electrical outlets at an apartment complex in the 5500 block of Roswell Road. SSFR personnel found water seeping into the ceiling through vents and electrical outlets of apartment G3. Personnel made contact with the resident in the unit above and found a leaking hot water heater. Crews shut off the valve feeding the hot water heater and the breaker controlling it. ChatComm and residents of both apartment units attempted, but were unable to make contact with building maintenance. SSFR personnel notified the residents of the impacted unit that the breakers in the apartment would need to remain off due to the fire hazard and assisted the residents with getting their necessities to their vehicle.
- Crews responded to reports of a water leak in an apartment complex in the 1100 block of Hammond Drive. They could hear what sounded like water raining down upon the floor. No one was home, and building maintenance advised SSFR to breach the door. A large amount of water was coming from the ceiling. Crews immediately went to the apartment directly above and found a large fish tank that had drained completely out with water running down into the two apartment units below. SSFR and maintenance personnel secured power to the impacted units. A cleaning/repair crew was called in to make needed repairs.

PUBLIC WORKS

CIP

- T-02 Abernathy Road/Johnson Ferry Road Improvements: Preliminary work to install pedestrian lighting on Abernathy Road between Wright Road and Brandon Mill, Abernathy Road between Wright Road and Roswell Road and Johnson Ferry Road from Abernathy Road to Long Island Drive is underway. Final completion is projected for March 2016. There will be come additional sidewalk work, brick paver installation and landscaping for the Johnson Ferry Road project.
- T-8 Roswell Road Streetscape from Carpenter Drive to Hammond Drive: Construction activities are projected to begin the end of this month with most of the construction occurring at night. Work is planned for completion in the summer. The project installs Downtown Overlay District streetscape features to include pedestrian lighting and landscaping, and it upgrades the sidewalk section to current accessibility standards.
- T-33 CDBG Sidewalks: The design and survey work to develop the overlay district-compliant streetscape on the west side of Roswell Road from I-285 to Long Island Drive is underway. A pedestrian scale street lighting project is also in design for the north side of Northridge Road from Roswell Road to Dunwoody Place with installation planned for the spring.
- T-34 Morgan Falls Road: Work is underway to provide sidewalks, retaining walls and associated features to improve pedestrian access along Morgan Falls Road to Overlook Park. Future roadway repaving and landscape projects will complement this current phase of work. **Due to the construction activities underway and the narrow roadway, motorists are urged to exercise caution and expect delays when traveling to Overlook Park.**
- T-45 Windsor Parkway at Roswell Road Intersection Relocation: Construction is underway to develop the new roadway and intersection. The project improves the alignment of the intersection of Windsor Parkway at Roswell Road with completion scheduled for spring 2016.
- Interstate North Parkway at Riveredge Parkway: The project adds signalization and turn lane improvements at this intersection, with completion planned for spring 2016.
- Heards at Raider Drive Intersection Improvement: The project adds turn lanes and new signalization at this intersection. It is scheduled to begin in the next few weeks in conjunction with utility relocations.
- Powers Ferry at Heards Road Intersection Improvement: The project to add turn lanes at this intersection is scheduled to begin in the next few weeks. Utility relocations are underway.
- Sidewalk Program:
 - FY2016 Sidewalk Program: An open period of 90 days was approved by Council to allow citizen groups and property owners the opportunity to donate any required right of way for the candidate projects in the interest of improving the overall score for their project. **As a reminder, the deadline for right of way donation statements is February 1, 2016 with final project scores due to Council on March 1, 2016.** Interested citizen groups with projects on the list are encouraged to contact Public Works customer service representatives for more information regarding right of way donation statements. Please see the most recent Sidewalk Program presentation on the City's Public Works Sidewalks page for more information on the right of way donation statements and the current list of candidate projects.

 - The consultant provided potential sections along Hammond Drive with traffic analysis and model split considerations.  - Project will make improvements to the streets in and around the intersection and under the I-285 bridge.  - Cabinet relocations to be performed at three intersections, and Sensys equipment to be installed at five intersections. Siemens is waiting for the temperature to rise in order to pour new signal cabinet concrete base at Glenridge Conn at Meridian Mark.
- T-7225-T7226 Powers Ferry Signals
 - Sodding for the island has been completed. Crews are working up a schedule for the punch list.

PROGRESS REPORT

Comprehensive Plan (Next Ten)

- Work on the Next Ten, the City Comprehensive Plan is proceeding. The planning team will return to Sandy Springs on January 26th to present an update to the Mayor and City Council at their annual retreat. **On January 27, 2016, the planning team will host a community meeting at the Sherwood Event Center on Roswell Road beginning at 6 p.m.**
- During the January 5, 2016 meeting, the City Council affirmed the Mayor’s appointment of a Zoning Advisory Committee. This group will work with the consultant preparing the new zoning ordinance to ensure that changes are reflective of the Sandy Springs that is desired by the

community. The Zoning Advisory Committee will hold their first meeting on January 28, 2016 to review the scope of the work and to prepare for the development of the code.

- The Planning team hosted an online/phone meeting with representatives of Fulton County Schools.

North Fulton Transportation Plan

- City Council approved a memorandum of understanding with other North Fulton localities to join together with the Atlanta Regional Commission to develop an update to the North Fulton Transportation Plan. This planning process will look at regional transportation issues and develop plans to implement improvements. It is anticipated that the planning period will take approximately 15 to 18 months. The Request for Proposals has been advertised.

Impact Fees

- Staff presented a proposal to the Mayor and Council on November 3rd to study the current impact fees for appropriateness. City Council approved moving forward with the study. It is anticipated that a contract to perform the work will be presented to City Council at a December meeting. Impact Fees are assessed on projects in order to have new development pay for impacts to parks, public safety, and transportation generated by that development. A study of the current system will begin with recommendations to come to the Mayor and Council in early spring. Work to date has involved data collection and analysis.

 - Communications continues working with our City Springs construction team on outreach related to controlled blasting on the construction site as well as the planned lane closures on Sandy Springs Circle and Johnson Ferry Road, which will begin in February.
 - Staff is working with Fire Rescue on outreach related to inspections for private hydrants, which should be inspected annually.
- Events:
 - The City's annual MLK Day Celebration took place on Monday, with Council Chambers filled as Tillie O-Neal-Kyles of Every Woman Works received the Humanitarian Award and Fulton County Commission Chair John Eaves delivered the keynote address.
 - Communications is working with the City's arborists in preparation for the February 19th Arbor Day celebration, which will take place at Hammond Park.
 - Hospitality and Tourism and Communications met to discuss ideas to bring new events to the city in 2016.
 - Touch base phone meetings were held regarding a food event in creation between Savor Sandy Springs and the creator of Taste of Atlanta. The event will take place on May 14, 2016 at Hammond Park.
 - The Atlanta Jewish Film Festival begins on January 26 with many of the screenings at the LeFont Theater in Sandy Springs. Hospitality and Tourism is an event sponsor.
