

PUBLIC SAFETY

SSPD

North District

- There were five apartment burglaries between Spring Creek Lane and Addison with similarities between the crimes. The burglaries involved two black males driving a white Toyota Camry. Entry was gained through the front door using a crow bar, with miscellaneous electronics were taken from each location.
- North District had three entering autos in the 6000 block of Peachtree Dunwoody Road. The vehicles were entered by smashing a window. Miscellaneous electronics were taken.
- Officers responded to a burglary in progress call Ryefield Drive on Feb. 22, 2016. The address was a vacant home, and two subjects were found inside. The suspect told officers that they were planning to host a party at the dwelling. They were arrested for loitering.
- Officer Godfrey is working with 10 Glenlake Parkway on the completion of their emergency evacuation procedures.
- Work with Atlanta Intercontinental University (AIU) and the Art Institute of Atlanta on active shooter training is on-going.

South District

- Community Officers met with the staff at TLC Dentistry on Hildebrand Drive to set up an active-shooter response training class which will take place in April.
- Officer Begeal and Sgt. F. Bohannon led an active shooter class at Resurgeons. They also hosted a "Coffee with a Cop" – an opportunity for the community to interact with SSPD over a cup of coffee. The event was held at Dunkin' Donuts, and another Coffee is in the works to be held at Buttermilk Sky.
- Captain Rose and Sergeant F. Bohannon participated in a meeting held with neighbors near the closure at Windsor Parkway and Jolyn. The purpose of the meeting, hosted by Councilman DeJulio, was to update the community on repairs to the road as well as listen to concerns about traffic issues related the closure.
- Officer Begeal taught a senior crime prevention class at Mt. Vernon Towers on February 26, 2016.
- A Target Store employee was arrested and charged with stealing. The employee is accused of ringing up items for another employee and then voiding the order. The funds amounted to just under \$100.
- SSPD is working on a series of strong-arm robberies taking place following each victim's stop at a Bank of America. Detectives are checking for similarities in the cases, believing them to be related to the same suspect/s.

Street Crimes Unit

- The Unit completed one felony arrest, three misdemeanor arrests, and located two wanted persons. The Unit worked one drug complaint, spent 10 hours on surveillance, and spent three hours assisting other units.
- On February 23rd, Captain Mullin and Sgt. Laughman attended the NHTSA safety summit at the Georgia State Patrol. Traffic safety measures were discussed by a group of law enforcement and private sector professionals. There were more than 35,000 traffic fatalities in the U.S. during 2014. Those figures are expected to go up by approximately 8 percent for 2015, once the final numbers are in. The top three factors involved in traffic fatalities were speed, impairment (DUI, fatigue, distraction), and unrestrained motorists. These figures will aid the SSPD in planning

future traffic enforcement details, such as sobriety checkpoints, nighttime seatbelt enforcement and quarterly traffic fatality reviews.

- On February 23rd, members of the Street Crimes Unit worked a protection detail for Governor John Kasich of Ohio, who hosted a town hall meeting at city hall as part of his presidential campaign.
- On February 24th, Street Crime Unit officers arrested Richard Limones at a hotel in the Roswell area. Mr. Limones was wanted by SSPD on 33 warrants including multiple counts of entering auto.
- Officer T. Snow of Street Crimes worked on gathering warrants and location information for numerous SSPD felony warrants as part of an upcoming operation to be worked with the U.S. Marshals office.
- Officer Snow arrested a suspicious person who was wanted out of Douglas County. The arrest occurred near the leasing office of 7150 Peachtree Dunwoody Road.
- Members of the Street Crimes unit proactively patrolled the area of Hampton Drive due to a recent "rash" of burglaries.

Special Investigations Unit (SIU)

- The Unit followed up on a suspicious activity complaint at River Exchange Drive. Following a positive K-9 sniff, a search warrant was served. The location was found to be a suspected meth conversion lab. The DEA Clandestine Lab Team along with GBI responded, with approximately one ounce of meth seized.

K9 Unit

- Officer Stark continued with his K-9 training in Florida. His scheduled graduation date is March 11th.
- The Unit completed five traffic stops and issued five citations. Two K-9 searches were completed, and one suspicious vehicle stop. The Unit spent eight hours assisting other units with 11 grams of methamphetamine seized.
- The Unit conducted a package sniff for the U.S. Postal Inspectors, and focused patrol efforts on "hot spot" areas in the hotel district.

Traffic

- The Unit made 12 traffic stops with 14 citations issued. The Unit made one misdemeanor arrest, and spent 2.5 hours working traffic complaints.
- Members of the Traffic Unit are assisting with afternoon traffic at Meadowbrook Drive and Windsor Parkway, where a detour is in place due to an emergency road closure.
- The Traffic Unit worked a complaint in the Riverside neighborhood and arrested one person for driving on a suspended license. Officer Smith also worked complaints at Trowbridge and Abernathy/Johnson Ferry.
- The Traffic Unit deployed a speed detection trailer on Bonnie Lane.
- The Unit worked a detail at the intersection of water main break near Cox Communications.
- DUI: The Unit worked 58.75 hours issuing four DUI arrests, two misdemeanor arrests, and issuing 13 citations.

Criminal Investigations Division

- The Unit is working with Target Loss Prevention on four cases involving employees.
- An investigation continues related to an individual who had his cell phone stolen from McDonalds.

Crime Scene Investigations (CSI)

- The Unit spent three hours working on various cases conducting fingerprint analysis and verification. The Unit also conducted fingerprint training with the new SSPD Recruits.

- The Unit is working on processing cell phones for various cases.

Community Affairs

- The Firearms Safety Class is full through June.
- The next Citizens Police Academy class begins Tuesday, March 8th.
- Chief DeSimone attended a retirement reception for SAC (USSS) R. Moore. He also participated in a GILEE Board meeting.

Volunteers

- The Citizens on Patrol Unit (COPS) worked 274 hours and conducted 41 shifts this past week. They conducted 12 house checks and issued 19 handicap parking citations. A total of 1,336 miles were covered on patrol with the majority of that time focusing on residential and target areas.
- The second training session for COPS Class #7 was taught by Fire Rescue's Patrick Flaherty.
- COPS has begun its SR-13 program. This is a pilot program in which trained COPS volunteers will complete the necessary on scene paperwork related to accidents on private property, freeing sworn officers to concentrate on other police duties.
- The COPS program has provided several units during the week to assist the North District with traffic control at Roswell Road and Franklin Road. The assistance is needed while repairs are underway at Windsor Parkway and Jolyn.
- COPS volunteers also learned how to move the Police Department traffic control trailer into positions as directed by the Traffic Unit. COPS members were assisted by two Traffic Unit officers to ensure the COPS set up the device correctly as taught by the Traffic Unit. There is one COPS vehicle outfitted with towing capability to move these devices as requested. This program is another example of activities where COPS volunteers can provide assistance, enabling sworn officers to concentrate on high priority matters.

SSFR

Operations:

- Responded to a total of 255 calls: Two Fires, 121 EMS calls, 21 Service Calls, 78 Good Intent Calls, 21 False Alarms
- Crews responded to a reported structure fire at a single family dwelling in the 5600 block of Colton Drive. Initially, they found nothing showing, but further investigation revealed that food in the bottom of the stove had burned off, causing smoke to fill the residence.
- Crews were dispatched to the 5000 block of Roswell Road on reports of an activated fire alarm which was upgraded to a possible structure fire. Crews found food which had burned on the stove in an apartment unit. The occupants stated that they had left food cooking unattended.
- Crews responded to a tree down on power lines on Colewood Way. A very large pine tree was down in the school parking lot, along with all main power lines. The power lines were stretched across approximately 20 vehicles, and the tree was across multiple vehicles as well. While there was damage to multiple vehicles, no injuries were reported. Crews remained on scene, setting up a safe zone for bystanders until Georgia Power arrived on scene.

TRANSPORTATION

PROJECTS PROVIDING MAJOR TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- **Windsor Parkway and Jolyn Place** – Baldwin Construction began work Monday to repair Windsor Parkway at Jolyn. An underground wall is under construction as part of shoring efforts to enable the road to reopen. The closure remains in place with Franklin Road the designated detour until repairs are completed. SSPD & Citizens on Patrol continue to provide traffic control support on Meadowbrook at Roswell Rd and Franklin and Roswell Rd during a.m. and p.m. peak hours. Motorists should expect the closure to be in place through mid April. Information regarding the closure and updates on the road repairs can be found on the City’s website – www.sandyspringsga.gov/windsor
- **Roswell Road from Cliftwood to Hammond Dr** – Construction as part of the Streetscape project is underway, with activity on both sides of Roswell Road. Construction work will take place primarily at night (9:30 p – 6:30a) with lane closures also in place during construction hours. Tree removal associated with this project is expected to begin the week of March 7, 2016.
- **Johnson Ferry Road** (Marsh Creek project) – The lane closure on the northern most lane on Johnson Ferry Road beginning at Ferry Drive and ending just before Sandy Springs Circle should be completed on Saturday, March 5, weather permitting.
- **I-285/Riverside Drive** –The more active construction is expected to begin in the spring and will take place both day and night; however, lane closures will only take place during weeknights from 9 p.m. – 5 a.m., and on weekends from 8 p.m. – 10 a.m. One travel lane will remain open at all times, except during bridge maintenance work, when all lanes in each direction will close and a detour will be in place.

CIP

- T-02 Abernathy Road/Johnson Ferry Road Improvements: Preliminary work to install pedestrian lighting on Abernathy Road between Wright Road and Brandon Mill, Abernathy Road between Wright Road and Roswell Road and Johnson Ferry Road from Abernathy Road to Long Island Drive is underway. Additional sidewalk work, brick paver installation and landscaping for the Johnson Ferry Road project is also planned. Lighting is scheduled to be installed on the south side of Abernathy from Roswell Road to Johnson Ferry.
- T-8 Roswell Road Streetscape from Carpenter Drive to Hammond Drive: The contractor has begun to mobilize in preparation for the start of construction activities with much of the construction activities occurring at night. The project installs Downtown Overlay District streetscape features to include pedestrian lighting and landscaping, and upgrades the sidewalk section to current accessibility standards.

- T-33 CDBG Sidewalks: The design and survey work to develop the overlay district-compliant streetscape on the west side of Roswell Road from I-285 to Long Island Drive is underway. A pedestrian scale street lighting project is also in design for the north side of Northridge Road from Roswell Road to Dunwoody Place with installation planned for the spring.
- T-34 Morgan Falls Road: Work continues with future roadway repaving and landscape projects to complement this current phase of work. Due to the construction activities underway and the narrow roadway, motorists are urged to exercise caution and expect delays when traveling to Overlook Park.
- T-43 Glenridge Drive at Roswell Road Intersection: The project concept drawing and associated project fact sheets are on display at City Hall and on the City's project web page.
- T-45 Windsor Parkway at Roswell Road Intersection Relocation: Construction is underway to develop the new roadway and intersection. The project improves the alignment of the intersection of Windsor Parkway at Roswell Road with completion scheduled for spring 2016.
- CC-10 Sandy Springs Circle Streetscape, Phase II: **A public open house is planned for March 9, 2016 from 6 – 8 p.m.** at the Sandy Springs United Methodist Church Activities Center (best known as Hitson Center), located at 85 Mt Vernon Highway. The project offers streetscape and roadway enhancement on Sandy Springs Circle from Mt Vernon Road to Hammond Drive, including a multi-purpose trail.
- Interstate North Parkway at Riveredge Parkway: The project adds signalization and turn lane improvements at this intersection. Signal installation and paving are scheduled to take place over the next month.
- Heards at Raider Drive Intersection Improvement: The project adds turn lanes and new signalization at this intersection. Construction begins over the next week, in conjunction with utility relocations.
- Powers Ferry at Heards Road Intersection Improvement: Utility relocations and site grading are underway.
- Sidewalk Program:
 - Glenridge Drive at Greenland Sidewalk: Design is nearly to extend existing sidewalk east to the intersection of Glenridge and Greenland on the south side of Glenridge Drive.

Transportation Division

- R-13002 Glenridge @ I-285 Ramp Widening
 - The contractor has installed the 12" and the 8" signal heads and will stripe the stop bar.
- R-14090 O/D Study for Riverside Drive
 - Study of Sandy Springs east to west from the Chattahoochee River to the City of Dunwoody limits and north to south from Johnson Ferry Road/Abernathy to Glenridge Drive.
 - Final methodology report and AL1 graphic has been submitted by the consultant which is under review by staff.
- R-15136 City Scoot 2015 - Adaptive at Northside Drive Node
 - Project will install adaptive traffic control to 8 intersections in and around the Northside Drive @ I-285 node and two intersections on Spalding Drive east of Roswell Road.
 - Cabinet work is complete.
- R-15151 HFES School Flashers
 - The Radar Sign and Flasher Construction is completed, and the units are operational. "END SCHOOL ZONE" signs at appropriate locations are still to be installed.
- R-15193 Fulton County Transportation Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax

- Coordination with Fulton County related to possible T-SPLOST referendum in November 2016. The Consultant team met with management to discuss project list. Project team meetings are scheduled for March 9, 16, and 23, 2016.
- T-0054 ATMS 3 - Glenridge, Hammond, PTD
 - Project installs adaptive traffic control on 27 signals on and near Glenridge Drive, Hammond Drive and Peachtree Dunwoody Road. Staff sent revised plans to Georgia Power for review.
- T-7149 Mount Paran @ Powers Ferry Rd Signal Design
 - Project will signalize the existing intersection and provide pedestrian facilities.
 - GDOT is interested in the project as a possible off system grant project. Staff is working on questions regarding turn lanes and right-of-way conveyance schedule.
- R-14069 Mt. Vernon Walk VAF
 - Staff work is complete and awaiting Georgia Power.
- R-13011 Johnson Ferry Road Neighborhood Intersections
 - A gap study was requested for intersections of Johnson Ferry Road and Breakwater Ridge, and Johnson Ferry Road and North Harbor by the Assistant City Manager. A full gap study is underway. The number of illegal left turns from North Harbor onto Johnson Ferry Road will be recorded between 4pm and 7pm as part of the study.

NATURAL RESOURCE PROTECTION

Stormwater

- There are 43 identified projects: two are under construction, two under design, four in contract development, four in right-of-way/easement acquisition, three in technical review, 25 in scope development, and the remaining pending final invoice or inspection.
- Eleven new drainage work requests were received last week.
- 125 Kingsport Drive – A storm pipe will be lined. Layne Inliner will begin work as early as the week of March 14th.
- 145 Landsdowne Drive – A headwall will be replaced. A schedule is being coordinated with Blount.
- 4810 Rebel Trail – Catch basin tops were replaced and a structure was rebuilt. This project is complete.
- 4525 Mount Paran Parkway – A pipe will be lined. A schedule will be coordinated with Layne Inliner when the purchase order has been issued.
- 655 Glenairy Drive – A catch basin will be re-grouted and cast-iron hoods will be replaced. A schedule will be coordinated with the contractor once the purchase order has been issued.
- 6385 Riverside Drive – A catch basin will be re-built, and a concrete collar will be placed at a broken pipe joint. Pricing was due February 25th.
- 6445 Scott Valley Road – A pipe will be lined, and a second pipe will be replaced along with a headwall. A catch basin will be rebuilt. Pricing is due March 3rd.
- 4751 Mystic Drive – Two catch basins will receive new throats and tops, and the pipe connecting them will be lined. Pricing is due March 22nd.
- Windsor Parkway Stormwater Detention – Baldwin Construction began repairs to the impacted roadway resulting in the closure at Windsor and Jolyn. The bond company has 30 days to present the City with a plan to complete the stormwater detention project.
- Lake Forrest Dam – Siphons were installed on the outfall structure in order to drain the lake, one to two feet per week over a period of four to eight weeks. The schedule is dependent on the weather and the amount of rainfall received.
