

Week in Review: Week Ending 3-11-2016

PUBLIC SAFETY

SSPD

North District

- SSPD is investigating four entering autos outside the Regal Theatres on Mt Vernon and three entering autos reported at the Hyatt Regency on Crestline Parkway, with all occurring in the late hours of March 4, 2016.
- Officer McGovern was assaulted by a suicidal subject on Redbourn Drive. Officers assisted in the subsequent arrest of the subject, who was charged with felony obstruction and simple battery.
- Officers conducted active shooter training for Resurgens Surgery Center.

South District

- Two burglaries were reported in close proximity on Mt Vernon Highway. In the first, the complainant said the home was entered through a basement door by force, with a Viking refrigerator taken from the home. In the second incident, a video taken on scene indicates two male suspects attempting to enter the building, but were unsuccessful in gaining entry.
- South district units responded to the area of Riverside Dr. and I-285 where a victim was following a suspect who had just shot at his vehicle during what appeared to be a road rage incident. Officer Beach located the vehicle matching the description in the lookout. Officer Beach and Officer JP Smith stopped the vehicle, and detained the driver. Further investigation revealed the crime was committed in Dunwoody. The victim positively identified the suspect. The gun was also located. The investigation and perpetrator were turned over to Dunwoody PD.
- Officer Begeal met with Botwin Communications and the manager for Ray's on the River related to a new camera system being installed at the restaurant. The system includes an LPR (License Plate Reader) that will cover the parking lot and the adjacent River One covered parking area. SSPD is working with the group to set up accessibility for our personnel.
- Coffee with a Cop took place on March 1st at the Dunkin Donuts on Roswell Road. The event is held quarterly at various locations in the South District.
- Officer Begeal attended an HOA meeting in the W. Belle Isle area to talk with residents about criminal trespass warnings, burglary and entering auto prevention. He also taught a crime prevention class at the Campbell Stone Senior Living Facility.

Street Crimes Unit

- Members of the Street Crimes Unit (SCU) conducted 30 hours of surveillance, made two felony arrests, two misdemeanor arrests, issued two traffic citations and located two wanted persons.
- The Unit continued with proactive patrols of the Hampton Apartment complex that has been the site of a recent string of burglaries. They also conducted surveillance regarding a recent rash of robberies.
- Last Friday, members of SCU teamed with SIU to work a detail watching eight different undisclosed locations.
- SCU arrested two subjects who had 22 outstanding felony warrants related to weapons and drug offenses.

Special Investigations Unit (SIU)

- SIU assisted Street Crimes and Criminal Investigations with a robbery detail.
- The Unit made two felony arrests with a stolen vehicle recovered. The suspects were in the area to commit other 'entering auto' crimes, stopped by SIU.

K9 Unit

- The K-9 unit made nine traffic stops with 10 citations issued. There were:
 - Two K-9 tracks,

- One field contact,
- Three suspicious person contacts, and
- Two grams of Marijuana seized.
- The Unit spent five hours assisting other units.
- Officer Dewald conducted kennel inspections and prepared a presentation for new K-9s.
- Officer Reynnells patrolled South District “hop spot” areas. He also assisted SIU with a narcotics investigation on North Green Drive, and assisted patrol with a foot pursuit in Barrington Hills where he located the shoe of the offender.
- Officer Hanse conducted a vehicle sniff on a traffic stop and located Marijuana. He also patrolled the hotel district “hot spot” area.
- Officer Stark continued his K-9 handler training.

Traffic

- The Traffic Unit made 27 traffic stops and issued 41 citations. They made five misdemeanor arrests and located one wanted person. They spent three hours assisting other units and three hours assisting other agencies. Officer Sheffield and Officer B. Smith assisted the ATF with a traffic stop/warrant pull at the River Exchange Apartment complex.
- The traffic units worked traffic complaints at Abernathy Road/Wright Road, Dunwoody Place/Hope Road, and Abernathy at Johnson Ferry. The Unit also assisted with the Roswell Road/Franklin Road detour.

Criminal Investigations Division

- A customer claimed that she found two pills in her sandwich at the Firehouse Subs on Glenridge Drive. CID pulled video from store cameras and sent video and pills to the GBI for testing.
- The Unit is investigating a missing 19-year-old female. Her mother suspects the girl may be with her ex-boyfriend whom she has a Temporary Restraining Order in place. No contact has been made with the missing girl or her boyfriend.
- The Unit is investigating a stolen Lexus, taken from Spalding Drive. The victim suspects the thief is possibly someone she recently interviewed and hired for a job, but is not certain.
- Bank-affiliated Robberies:
 - An investigation is underway following the robbery of a customer at the Bank of America on Roswell Road and Wieuca Road. The victim left the bank carrying a bank bag with money. He made several stops including the Quick Shop where he works on Roswell Road. When he exited his vehicle, a black male wearing a ski mask approached him and grabbed the bank bag. After a short tussle, the suspect was able to get the bag of money and flee.
 - In a separate case, the victim was followed from the Bank of America located in Dunwoody to the Chevron on Mt Vernon Hwy. One suspect wearing dark clothing and a ski mask pointed a handgun at him as he approached the victim. The suspect demanded the bank bag. The suspect then got into the passenger seat of a small grey, older model vehicle that fled south on Boylston.
 - CST and SIU are assisting in these cases. Video has been obtained from several locations showing the vehicle being used. Bank video will take 2-3 months to obtain.
- A misdemeanor warrant is forthcoming for Frank Earl Pace, who is wanted out of Duluth as well as Sandy Springs for Theft by Deception. Pace is accused of selling three inoperable Apple products (one iPhone and two iPads) to the victim in the Sandy Springs case.
- Two warrants were obtained for giving a false name and forgery for a suspect accused of using stolen identities to apply for care credit and then obtaining dental work. The amount of work thus far is almost \$50,000.

Crime Scene Investigations (CSI) activity this week:

- Imaged computer for child porn case.
- Created bolo video for robbery cases.
- Processed items for prints.
- Two ATF eTraces on firearms.
- Process laptop and desktop computer on child pornography case for Forsyth County.
- Processed cell phone and tablet.
- Examined Marijuana for five different cases.

Community Affairs

- The Firearms Safety Class is full through June.
- Citizens Police Academy class #23 began this week with 12 attendees.
- Community Affairs participated in the Riverwood High School Career Fair.
- Police Explorers are gearing up for a competition within the next two weeks.

Volunteers

- The Citizens on Patrol Unit worked 145 hours and conducted 27 shifts this past week.
- They conducted 15 house checks and issued 21 handicap parking citations.
- A total of 971 miles were covered with the majority of that time focusing on residential and target areas. While on patrol, COPS issued six SR-13 forms for private property accidents. This is a **new program** being tested.
- The Unit is also taking over the responsibility for moving the traffic speed devices to various locations. During this week, there was one device moved to a location as requested by the Traffic Unit, freeing those sworn officers to handle other tasks.
- There is significant construction at the intersection of Roswell Road and Franklin Road causing problems for people entering and exiting these streets. Several COPS volunteers are assisting with traffic control at that location during the week.

SSFR

Operations:

- Responded to a total of 248 calls: Two Fires, 98 EMS calls, 19 Service Calls, 92 Good Intent Calls, 24 False Alarms
- Crews responded to a diesel fuel leak from a tractor trailer truck on I-285 westbound and Riverside Drive. The leak was quickly stopped, and the spill was contained to the asphalt; no soil affected. A Department of Transportation Hero unit off-loaded 30 gallons of fuel from the truck with a pump. There was approximately 50-60 gallons of product spilled onto the asphalt and approximately 40 gallons remaining in the tank after it was plugged. SSFR contacted the trucking company representative and advised them to contact a clean-up company for hazardous waste removal.
- Crews responded to the 400 block of North Harbor Drive for a possible electrical issue. The homeowner believed something was wrong with the wiring in the home. After checking all the appliances in the kitchen area with the Thermal Imaging Camera, crews checked the breakers and found one breaker tripped for the kitchen. While talking with the occupant, a neighbor called the home and told SSFR personnel his house had experienced a power surge at the same time, requesting a check his house as well. As personnel went to meet with the neighbor, they were met with multiple homeowners at the end of the driveway; all had experienced power surges at the same time. SSFR personnel split up and checked all the homes. Georgia Power was called to respond and SSFR was advised that the power company had set a new pole the day prior. Georgia Power arrived on scene and found that the neutral had not been installed properly causing the power surges. Georgia Power followed up with residents.

- Three Fire Safety Education Events with 175 participants: one Birthday Party, one Pre-K Fire Safety Education, and one Community event.
- SSFR also hosted a “Where There’s Smoke” event promoting smoke detector safety checks at The Harbor Pointe apartment complex with 80 people in attendance.

Public Information:

- Fire Chief Sanders attended the I-285 GA-400 Interchange Planning meeting. Chief Sanders and Division Commander Brown attended the Fulton County Schools Fire Marshal meeting to discuss safety and security protocols.
- Members of SSFR attended the Metro Atlanta EMS conference.
- Medical Services Officer Patrick Flaherty attended the North Fulton clinical EMROC meeting.

TRANSPORTATION

PROJECTS PROVIDING MAJOR TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- **Windsor Parkway and Jolyn Place** - Repairs to the roadway are moving forward quickly. Barring any unforeseen issues, the road should reopen in advance of the mid-April projections. Updates can be found on the City’s website - www.sandyspringsga.gov/windsor
- **Roswell Road from Cliftwood to Hammond Dr** - Construction as part of the Streetscape project is underway, with activity on both sides of Roswell Road. Construction work will take place primarily at night (9:30 p - 6:30a) with **lane closures also in place during construction hours**. Tree removal associated with this project is underway.
- **I-285/Riverside Drive** -The more active construction is expected to begin in the spring and will take place both day and night; however, lane closures will only take place during weeknights from 9 p.m. - 5 a.m., and on weekends from 8 p.m. - 10 a.m. One travel lane will remain open at all times, except during bridge maintenance work, when all lanes in each direction will close and a detour will be in place.

The City maintains a **Road Work Advisory page** with updates on all planned lane and road closures and advisories. CIP

- **T-02 Abernathy Road/Johnson Ferry Road Improvements:** Preliminary work to install pedestrian lighting on Abernathy Road between Wright Road and Brandon Mill, Abernathy Road between Wright Road and Roswell Road and Johnson Ferry Road from Abernathy Road to Long Island Drive is underway.
- **T-8 Roswell Road Streetscape from Carpenter Drive to Hammond Drive:** The contractor will begin construction activities next week with much of the construction activities occurring at night. The project installs Downtown Overlay District streetscape features to include pedestrian lighting and landscaping and upgrades the sidewalk section to current accessibility standards.
- **CC-10 Sandy Springs Circle Streetscape, Phase II:** A Public Open House was held this week for the community to look at project concept designs and ask questions. About 80 people attended the meeting. This project offers streetscape and roadway enhancement on Sandy Springs Circle from Mt. Vernon Road to Hammond Drive as well

as a multi-purpose trail. Right of way acquisition efforts are planned to begin next year upon completion of project environmental coordination.

- T-33 CDBG Sidewalks: Design and survey work to develop the overlay district-compliant streetscape on the west side of Roswell Road from I-285 to Long Island Drive is underway. A pedestrian scale street lighting project is being advertised for construction bids for the north side of Northridge Road from Roswell Road to Dunwoody Place.
- T-34 Morgan Falls Road: Work continues to install sidewalks, retaining walls and associated features to improve pedestrian access along Morgan Falls Road to Overlook Park. **Due to the construction activities underway and the narrow roadway, motorists are urged to exercise caution and expect delays when traveling to Overlook Park.**
- T-45 Windsor Parkway at Roswell Road Intersection Relocation: Construction is underway to develop the new roadway and intersection.
- T-46 Carpenter Drive/Cliftwood Drive at Roswell Road Intersection Improvement: Design work and utility coordination is nearly complete on this project to realign the intersections of Cliftwood and Carpenter on Roswell Road. A Public Open House is scheduled for late March to update plans on needed lane/road closures.
- Interstate North Parkway at Riveredge Parkway: The new intersection and traffic signals are scheduled to be operational next week.
- Heards at Raider Drive Intersection Improvement: This project to add turn lanes and new signalization is underway.
- Powers Ferry at Heards Road Intersection Improvement: The project to add turn lanes at this intersection is underway.
- Sidewalk Program:
 - FY2016 Sidewalk Program: Scoring is complete and the results have been presented to Council for this year's Capital Sidewalk Program. Staff is currently working to begin design on the approved projects. Please see the most recent Sidewalk Program presentation on the City's Public Works Sidewalks page for more information on the Sidewalk Program and the current list of projects.
 - Brandon Mill from West Spalding to Marsh Creek Bridge Sidewalk: Design is underway in support of installation of sidewalk on Brandon Mill from West Spalding to the Marsh Creek Bridge.
 - Glenridge Drive at Greenland Sidewalk: Design is complete to extend existing sidewalk east to the intersection of Glenridge and Greenland on the south side of Glenridge Drive. Construction is planned for later this year.

Transportation Division

- FY 2016 Long Line Striping Program: The Notice to Proceed meeting was rescheduled for March 10, 2016.
- R-14127 Glance System Upgrade: Spalding and Mt. Vernon are now complete.
- R-15136 City Scoot 2015 - Adaptive at Northside Drive Node: Construction started this week.
- R-15137 Hammond Drive Study: The consultant provided potential sections along Hammond Drive with traffic analysis and model split considerations. Staff has prepared a presentation for inclusion in the work session of the March 15th Council Meeting.
- R-15151 HFES School Flashers: Staff met with the contractor to install updated Glance units to monitor radar sign data.
- R-15183 Mt. Vernon @ Spalding: Contractor completed the street lighting arm installation. This project is now complete.

- T-0044 ATMS 2 Project: Staff anticipates a Notice to Proceed to be issues late next week.

Field Services

- Pave On is expected to start end of March/first of April.

NATURAL RESOURCE PROTECTION

Stormwater

- There are 42 identified projects: two are under construction, nine in contract development, three in right-of-way/easement acquisition, 25 in scope development, and the remaining pending final invoice or inspection.
- Eight new drainage work requests were received last week.
- 430 Highbrook Drive - Blount Construction commenced construction this week.
- 145 Landsdowne Drive - A headwall will be replaced. Blount will begin work the week of March 14th.
- 125 Kingsport Drive - A storm pipe will be lined. Layne Inliner will begin work the week of March 21st.
- 4525 Mount Paran Parkway - A storm pipe will be lined. A schedule will be coordinated with Layne Inliner.
- 655 Glenairy Drive - A catch basin will be re-grouted, and cast-iron hoods will be replaced. A schedule will be coordinated with the contractor once the purchase order has been issued.
- 6385 Riverside Drive - A catch basin will be re-built, and a concrete collar will be placed at a broken pipe joint. A schedule will be coordinated with Blount once the purchase order is received.
- 6445 Scott Valley Road - A pipe will be replaced along with a headwall, and a catch basin will be rebuilt. Pricing is due March 11th.
- 4751 Mystic Drive - Two catch basins will receive new throats and tops, and the pipe connecting them will be lined. Pricing is due March 22nd.
- 6180 Riverwood Drive - A headwall and detention pond wall will be rebuilt. Pricing is due March 24th.

ENVIRONMENTAL COURT was held March 4, 2016 - Five defendants were scheduled to appear in municipal court charged with 20 municipal code violations. One defendant with one charge was adjudicated with fines assessed. One defendant with two charges failed to appear. Three defendants with 17 charges were reset for future court dates.

ENFORCEMENT EFFORTS

- 5545 LAKE ISLAND DRIVE (TREWINS HOMES) - A Notice of Violation was issued for failing to properly install and maintain the silt fence, and for failing to stabilize disturbance with vegetation.
- 4685 LAKE FORREST (ASCENT CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT) - A Stop Work Order and Citation were issued for failing to properly install and maintain the silt fence, failing to install the construction exit, tracking the street while failing to have a construction, failing to install the tree protection fence, and failing to properly post the permits and site plan.

COMMUNITY APPEARANCE

- A total of 20 signs were removed from the City's rights-of-way during sign sweeps.
- Field Services crews completed 389 work orders:
 - Eight - Trim vegetation, debris pickup, dead animal removal
 - 234 - Trash pick-up from various rights-of-way throughout the city
 - 143 - Trash pick-up from SR 400 and I-285 and 21 signs
 - Four - General maintenance work orders were completed last week.

Next Ten

Other meetings will be with staff, PCID representatives, and others to review the preliminary recommendations for the north end of Roswell Road and the PCID area.
