

PUBLIC SAFETY

SSPD

North District

Crime:

- We had eight “entering auto” cases this week. Seven were around apartment complexes near Roswell Road and Dunwoody Place. There was one reported case in the 7000 block of Roswell Road. Two cars were taken in the same apartment complexes.
- One burglary on Monterrey Parkway was reported.
- Community: Officer Godfrey met with representatives from Allied Barton and Corporate affiliates at 6600 Peachtree Dunwoody Road regarding active shooter training.

South District

- Two air conditioning units stolen from a house under construction on Mt. Vernon Pkwy.
- A suspicious female was trying to purchase a \$500 gift card with a stolen AMEX card at Target. The card was tracked as stolen from a locker at Lifetime Fitness. The suspect’s vehicle and tag information were obtained from the security cameras.
- AT&T Store 4600 Roswell Rd. Two suspects worked together in the AT&T store on Roswell Road with one suspect distracting the salesman while the other took headphones and speakers.

Street Crimes Unit (SCU)

- The Unit made one felony arrest, six misdemeanor arrests, three city arrests, and conducted 18 traffic stops with 14 citations issued. They located two wanted persons.
- Arrests:
 - Subject arrested for misdemeanor Failure to Appear and False Representation to Police.
 - Subject arrested on two city alcohol charges.
 - Subject arrested for Suspended License and a traffic charge.
 - Subject arrested for felony Terroristic Threats on a warrant.
 - Subject arrested for misdemeanor Theft by Receiving and two traffic charges.
- SCU assisted with a drug and weapons investigation at Cedar Run.

Special Investigations Unit (SIU)

- The Unit made four city arrests and worked three drug complaints. They spent 18 hours on surveillance and conducted three knock and talk investigations.
- The Unit also arrested two subjects for Loitering and Prowling and Disorderly Conduct. They conducted a drug investigation at Cedar Run and continue their investigation into a stolen police rifle.

Traffic Unit

- The Unit made two misdemeanor arrests, two DUI arrests, conducted 48 traffic stops with 50 citations issued, and worked 55 hours on traffic complaints.
- The Traffic Response Vehicle worked five impounds, eight crash calls, and conducted ten patrol assists. They changed six flat tires and dispensed three gallons of gasoline. There were 61 calls for service, and the Unit covered 439 miles.
- Members of the traffic unit continue to monitor/work detour at Mt. Vernon/Sandy Springs Circle where that intersection is closed.
- Officers attended accident reconstruction Level 5 training.

K9 Unit

- The Unit had one felony arrest, two misdemeanor arrests, and worked 39 traffic stops with 28 citations issued. They conducted seven K9 searches and spent 13 hours assisting other units.

- Members of K9 team assisted with an Entering Auto detail.
- Officer Stark was called out for a K9 track involving three car-jacking suspects from Dunwoody. The track led to a backpack dropped by one of the suspects. All three suspects were later apprehended.
- Officer Dewald and K9 Rock assisted with the apprehension of a demented subject. During the apprehension, K9 Rock was again injured after suspect struck him with a pipe. He is recovering from that injury.

Criminal Investigations Division

- Fraud- Roswell Road: The victim, who lives in Canada, was a target of a wire transfer fraud totaling approximately \$300,000.00. One suspect was identified; however, the investigation is ongoing related to IRS and Homeland Security implications.

Community Affairs

- The COP class completed the Citizens on Patrol Vehicle Operations Course training this week.

Volunteers

- The Citizens on Patrol Unit worked 159 hours and conducted 24 shifts this past week.
- They conducted 23 house checks and issued three handicap-parking citations.
- A total of 603 miles were covered on patrol with the majority of that time focusing on residential and target areas.

SSFR

Operations:

- Responded to a total of 256 calls: five fires, 93 EMS calls, 28 Service Calls, 104 Good Intent Calls, 19 False Alarms
- Cyano-kits, used for the treatment of hydrogen cyanide poisoning, were placed on all Advanced Medical Life Support units.
- Crews responded to the 7700 block of Highland Bluff Road on reports of a fire, finding light smoke coming from the rear side of the structure. A fire was located on the second floor deck and basement level. The fires were extinguished.
- Crews responded to reports of a vehicle fire in a parking lot at the 8100 block of Roswell Road. The vehicle was burning from the engine compartment to the windshield. Crews extinguished the fire.

TRANSPORTATION

T-SPLOST

- The City Council was briefed during its May 17, 2016 meeting regarding results from three public meetings held related to the City's proposed projects for T-SPLOST. The City took in feedback during the three meetings, along with feedback from a web survey. The results showed general support for the proposed projects. The City Council will vote on approval of the list during its June 7, 2016 meeting. Residents can view that presentation at www.sandyspringsga.gov/tsplost.

PROJECTS PROVIDING MAJOR TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- The needed relocation of utilities was completed on schedule, and work crews are now focused on final repairs and paving at the **intersection of Mt Vernon and Sandy Springs Circle**. The reopening of the intersection remains on schedule for early summer (mid-June). The next phase of road work in that area will be trench work needed on Sandy Springs Circle. The road will remain open, with a rolling lane closures in place. **Please note that the businesses in that area are open during the road construction period and will appreciate the community's continued patronage.**
- AT&T will conduct underground utility work at the intersection of Johnson Ferry Road and Sandy Springs Circle, directly in front of Fire Station #2 on Saturday, May 21 from 7 p.m. – 7 a.m. Sunday, and on Sunday, May 22, from 7 p.m. until 5:00 a.m. Monday. The **right turn lane will be closed** while work is underway.
- Georgia Power and Comcast will be conducting utility work on **Hilderbrand Road beginning Monday, May 23, which will necessitate closures** at Sandy Springs Circle and Hilderbrand and at Hilderbrand Drive and Blue Stone Road. Work hours will be 7 a.m. – 4 p.m. with the intersections open for afternoon commutes. Motorists will be able to access all businesses in that area during the construction period. It is hoped that all work will be completed within the week.
- Night paving begins Monday, May 23 on **Peachtree Dunwoody Road** with lane closures needed in the work zones. Work will take place through May 26. Daytime work will take place between 9 a.m. – 4 p.m. Night work needed will take place between 8 p.m. and completed by 6 a.m.
- Intersection improvements have begun at **Colquitt and Northridge**. Lane closures are part of the work plan. GDOT is managing the construction.
- Tuesday, May 24, Georgia Power will install a new transmission pole at the new Bank of America on Roswell Road. Minor lane disruptions could take place, but are expected to last approximately 15 minutes at a time.
- **Roswell Road from Cliftwood to Hammond Dr** – Streetscape construction continues, with activity on both sides of Roswell Road. Construction work will take place primarily at night (9:30 p – 6:30a) with **lane closures also in place during construction hours**.
- **I-285/Riverside Drive** – Any needed lane closures for this GDOT project will take place during weeknights from 9 p.m. – 5 a.m., and on weekends from 8 p.m. – 10 a.m. One travel lane will remain open at all times, except during bridge maintenance work, when all lanes in each direction will close and a detour will be in place.

CIP

- T-8 Roswell Road Streetscape from Carpenter Drive to Hammond Drive: Construction continues with much of the construction activities occurring at night.
- T-33 CDBG Sidewalks: The design and survey work to develop the overlay district-compliant streetscape on the west side of Roswell Road from I-285 to Long Island Drive is underway. Bids are due in May.
- T-34 Morgan Falls Road: A paving contract was approved, with paving taking place this summer. Construction work is nearly complete to sidewalks, retaining walls and associated features to improve pedestrian access along Morgan Falls Road to Overlook Park.
- T-45 Windsor Parkway at Roswell Road Intersection Relocation: The new intersection opened for traffic on April 11, 2016. The old intersection of Windsor Parkway and Roswell Road is now closed to through traffic. Reconstruction of Hedden Street and Windsor Parkway intersection is underway. Motorists are urged to exercise caution while construction activities continue to complete this project.
- T-46 Carpenter Drive/Cliftwood Drive at Roswell Road Intersection Improvement: The project is being advertised for bids with construction to follow over the next year.
- Glenridge Drive at Greenland Sidewalk: The construction project is being advertised for bids, with construction planned for later this year.
