

Week in Review: Week Ending 6-11-2016

PUBLIC SAFETY

SSPD

North District

Crime:

- Thefts: Several bundles of roofing shingles were stolen from 7150 Roswell Road and a Jacuzzi pump was reported missing from 410 Glenmont Court.
- Auto Thefts: A 1997 Honda Accord taken from 1155 Mt. Vernon Highway; a 2009 Honda Accord stolen from 8117 Colquitt Road; a 2010 Audi A4 was reported missing at 545 Glengate Court; and an auto with two bikes attached was reported stolen from 725 Dalrymple Road.
- Four entering autos:
 - 7844 Kiverton Pl – An iPod and personal items were stolen. The vehicle was unlocked.
 - 2409 Harbor Pt. Pkwy - Personal items and tools were taken.

Community:

- Officer Godfrey conducted active shooter training at Holy Spirit. He also taught a class at the Citizens Police Academy and participated in the Special Olympics Fundraising campaign at the Dunkin Donuts this past week.

South District

- 285WB/Paces Ferry Road: Patrol received a call of an erratic driver on I-285. Officers encountered the suspect on I-285WB near Riverside Dr. The driver of the black Toyota Camry, a female, refused to stop for officers. She made U-turns on the interstate and drove the wrong way. Sandy Springs officers, along with Cobb County officers, were eventually able to box the driver in on I-285EB and Paces Ferry Rd. The driver was taken into custody without any further incident.
- 5450 Interstate North Pkwy - Entering Auto: A purse containing a Georgia license and \$20 in cash stolen after the driver's side window was smashed in and the thief grabbed the items from inside.
- 5825 Glenridge Dr. Suite 245-Robbery: An armed male suspect robbed a mobile catering business. No injuries were reported. The victims believe that the suspect may be a current or former employee.
- 6345 Powers Ferry Road - Entering Auto: The victim in this case had two females that he met at a bar come to his hotel. When he woke up, he noticed that his car keys were in a different place, and his Air Jordan shoes and a bottle of liquor were missing. It is not known if the females had anything to do with the disappearing items.
- 805 Mt. Vernon Hwy, Entering Auto: A vehicle window was broken, but nothing was taken.

Street Crimes Unit (SCU)

- The Unit made two felony arrests, five misdemeanor arrests, one city arrest, conducted three traffic stops, and located two wanted persons. The Unit completed 12 hours of surveillance, conducted three knock and talk investigations and seized 9.3 grams of marijuana.
- SCU/SIU officers arrested two offenders after they attempted to flee from SCU during a traffic stop. A check on the vehicle indicated it was stolen out of Wisconsin. The female passenger of the vehicle was wanted for parole violation for Burglary out of Wisconsin.

- SCU conducted an “entering auto” prevention detail at the Churches along the Mount Vernon Highway corridor.
- Officers Cannon and W. Johnson participated in a Juvenile Court trial for the 14-year-old driver in the entering auto/pursuit initiated at Chimen De Vie. The Juvenile was found guilty on all 11 charges and was remanded back into custody.

Special Investigations Unit (SIU)

- The Unit conducted surveillance at 201 Northwood Drive. A traffic stop performed on suspicious vehicle located 9.3gm of marijuana. Disorderly Conduct charges and traffic charges followed for the driver.
- The Unit provided assistance for the K9 with a US Parcel case.
- The Unit served a warrant for a person wanted on a Simple Battery Case.

Traffic Unit

- The Unit made one misdemeanor arrest, one DUI arrest, and conducted 32 traffic stops, issuing 34 citations. The Unit spent 16 hours working traffic complaints, 24 hours assisting other units and worked one call out.
- The Traffic Response Vehicle impounded two vehicles, answered three crash calls, and provided eight patrol assists. The Unit changed ten flat tires and dispensed five gallons of gasoline. The TRV had 55 self-initiated calls and covered 522 miles on patrol.
- Traffic unit members continue to assist with the road closure detail at Sandy Springs Circle and Mt. Vernon Hwy.
- Members of the traffic unit were called in to investigate a single car, one-occupant traffic fatality on GA 400 Southbound at Hammond Drive.

K9 Unit

- The Unit conducted five misdemeanor arrests, 25 traffic stops and issued 28 citations. The Unit located one wanted person, made three suspicious person/vehicle stops, and conducted 21 K9 searches. They worked one drug complaint, conducted 14 knock and talk investigations, and issued 11 search warrants. The Unit seized three ounces of marijuana, 9.5 kilos of methamphetamine (22 pounds), 17 kilos of heroin (37 Pounds) and \$83K in cash.
- Officers assisted the United States Postal Service with an interdiction detail at the airport logistics center. Fifteen, five parcel line ups were conducted which resulted in 12 positive K9 alerts; 11 of those contained illegal narcotics or drug proceeds.

Criminal Investigations Division

- A juvenile offender responsible for an entering auto crime at the Wyndham hotel was arrested this week by College Park Police. He is currently at the metro youth detention center.
- Blood evidence was found, collected, and submitted to the GBI from both victims’ vehicles in an entering auto case. A match was received on the submitted DNA, and contact was made with the suspect’s parole officer to collect a comparison DNA sample.
- A person of interest has been identified and coordination is underway with the U.S. Postal Inspector related to an identify theft case. The victim learned that someone opened a bank account in his name, using a Jefferson Drive address.
- A suspect was arrested and confessed related to a theft case in which the victim hired a cleaning person through Handy.com. The person left prior to the work being completed and moments later, the victim’s credit card was used with transaction attempts equaling over \$1,100.

Crime Scene Investigations

- The Unit processed a computer for a child neglect case and two cell phones for the District Attorney’s office.

Community Affairs

- Citizen Police Academy Class #23 graduates on June 9th.

- Two Interns have started at SSPD.

Volunteers: Citizens on Patrol

- The Unit worked 194 hours and conducted 30 shifts this past week.
- They conducted 34 house checks and issued 31 handicap parking citations, covering 836 miles on patrol.

SSFR

Operations:

- Responded to a total of 248 calls: Nine Fires, 89 EMS calls, 24 Service Calls, 88 Good Intent Calls, and 32 False Alarms.
- Crews responded to a vehicle fire on I-285 westbound at GA-400. Upon arrival, crews found a U-Haul trailer with the passenger side tires on fire. The fire was extinguished, and no fire extension was found.
- Crews responded to a grill fire at the pool of an apartment complex in the 1100 block of Hammond Drive. They arrived to find bystanders applying extinguishers to two grills fixed into a long counter space with no access to the underside. Fire personnel applied water to the fire, but the fire reignited due to a gas leak contained underneath the counter. Crews located the gas shut off valve and were able to remove both grills from the counter. They found that one of the grills had burnt through the gas line causing the majority of the fire. After the grills were removed, the crew used the on-scene water hose to finish overhauling the underside of the counter. All burnt sections were removed to clean the wood and cool down the surface temperature.
- Crews responded to reports of an overturned vehicle at the intersection of Hammond Drive and Sandy Springs Circle. They found an individual trapped inside the vehicle and used hydraulic cutters to extricate him.
- Crews were dispatched to the scene of a dumpster fire in the 6300 block of Peachtree Dunwoody Road. They found the dumpster around the back of the motel, and the fire was extinguished with approximately 500 gallons of water. A trash hook was used to separate the rubbish inside the dumpster to check for hot spots.
- Crews were dispatched to reports of wires down in the 5600 block of Glen Errol Road with multiple callers stating power lines were on fire. They found power lines down with fire in front of a residence. A neighbor stated that the back deck was on fire. A water can was used to extinguish the bulk of the fire under the deck. Overhaul was done to the deck, and boards were removed. The hardwood flooring in the family room was removed at the fire area, and sheet rock was removed from downstairs.

- There were 135 inspections conducted with 80 violations cited.

Training:

- A community CPR Class was held for 18 teens as part of the Sandy Springs Recreation & Parks Recreation Service Work Day.
- Two car seat inspections were conducted with two adults trained.

Safety Education & Public Relations Events:

- Two Fire Safety Education events were held with 215 participants: One Pre-K Safety Education and one Station Tour.

Public Information:

- Community Affairs Officer Ware attended the Georgia State Firefighters Association District meeting and met with Holy Innocents Episcopal Church officials regarding a 9/11 service honoring firefighters.

TRANSPORTATION

PROJECTS WITH MAJOR TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Paving has begun at the **intersection of Mt Vernon and Sandy Springs Circle**. The project remains on schedule with vehicular traffic expected to resume at that intersection by June 20th. **Please note that the businesses in that area are open during the road construction period and will appreciate the community's continued patronage.**
- **Friday, June 11 - Mon, June 13 - Dunwoody Club Drive & Brookeridge Drive:** The City of Dunwoody is conducting road repairs to fix a damaged stormwater culvert. During construction, traffic will be reduced to one lane along the work area on Dunwoody Club. Flag crews will assist in directing traffic. For additional information, contact the City of Dunwoody Dept of Public Works - 678.382.6580 or email constuction@dunwoodyga.gov
- **Roswell Road from Cliftwood to Hammond Dr** – Streetscape construction continues, with activity on both sides of Roswell Road. Construction work will take place primarily at night (9:30 p – 6:30a) with **lane closures also in place during construction hours**.
- **I-285/Riverside Drive** – Any needed lane closures for this GDOT project will take place during weeknights from 9 p.m. – 5 a.m., and on weekends from 8 p.m. – 10 a.m. One travel lane will remain open at all times, except during bridge maintenance work, when all lanes in each direction will close and a detour will be in place.

CIP

- T-8 Roswell Road Streetscape from Carpenter Drive to Hammond Drive: Construction work continues to install Downtown Overlay District streetscape features to include pedestrian lighting and landscaping and sidewalk accessibility upgrades.
- CC-10 Sandy Springs Circle Streetscape, Phase II: Right-of-way acquisition efforts are underway with the recently approved updated Project Framework Agreement and the Right-of-Way Acquisition Agreement with GDOT.
- T-34 Morgan Falls Road: Installation work is complete with paving to take place in July and landscaping efforts to follow.
- T-45 Windsor Parkway at Roswell Road Intersection Relocation: Preparations are underway for final paving which should be completed within the next month.
- T-46 Carpenter Drive/Cliftwood Drive at Roswell Road Intersection Improvement: Construction bids are under review.
- Sidewalk Program:
 - Brandon Mill from West Spalding to Marsh Creek Bridge Sidewalk: The project is being advertised for construction bids for installation of sidewalk on Brandon Mill from West Spalding to the Marsh Creek Bridge.

- Glenridge Drive at Greenland Sidewalk: The construction project is being advertised for bids for a sidewalk project to extend existing sidewalk east to the intersection of Glenridge and Greenland on the south side of Glenridge Drive. Construction is planned for later this year.

Transportation

- R-13002 Glenridge @ I-285 Ramp Widening: Striping the lane extension was completed.
- R-13089 PCID PTOP: Perimeter Traffic Operations Program (PTOP) in the Perimeter Center Improvement District (PCID) to upgrade and synchronize the traffic signals throughout the district. The PCID area contains portions of three cities, Sandy Springs, Dunwoody, and Brookhaven. The program provides maintenance and daily operations of traffic signals in the PCID region. Staff is reviewing the PTOP Year 4 Scope and Cost Estimations.
- R-14043 PCID Coordination (Bicycle Strategy)-Bicycle Strategy Study: The Perimeter CID hired Sprinkle Consulting in 2014 to undertake a Bicycle Strategy Plan to increase bicycling within the Perimeter. Staff is working with the PCID to present their plans at a future Council meeting.
- R-15151 HFES School Flashers: The signs noting the End of School Zone at Heard's Ferry Elementary School were installed.
- T-7178 Dunwoody Club @ Jett Ferry: Restriping and signage project to address undersized intersection and safety. Staff is drafting a scope of work to obtain quotes for this work.
- T-0044 ATMS 2 Project: Federally funded GDOT project to install adaptive traffic control on Roswell Road from Abernathy Road to the City of Atlanta Limits, 27 intersections. PI# 0012629 Project Funding (\$1,650,000). Staff is reviewing the construction bids.
- T-7104 Spalding Drive at Darymple Road-Trowbridge Road: IIP FY16 project for evaluation of NB and SB left turn lanes proposal. Staff working to draft a scope of work for the construction drawings.
- T-7139 Spalding Drive at Twin Branches Road: Construction is underway for the ADA upgrade project.
- T-7232 Spalding Drive at Pitts Road: Concept layouts to accommodate SB and EB left turn storage at intersection. In preparation for FY17 project scoring, staff has obtained intersection counts and updated the volume score.

Field Services

- Paving: NWGP continues on Peachtree Dunwoody Road. Paving resumes next week during the day, south of the Glenridge Connector. Please watch for lane closures in the work zone.

NATURAL RESOURCE PROTECTION

Stormwater

- There are 55 identified projects: two are under construction, two are under design, five in contract development, two in right-of-way/easement acquisition, four in technical review, 37 in scope development, and the remaining pending final invoice or inspection.
- Five new drainage work requests were received last week.
- 425 Kenbrook Drive – A pipe will be replaced, and new catch basin tops will be installed. A purchase requisition will be submitted when funding is available.
- 110 Bayvale Court – A pipe will be replaced, along with a headwall and manhole. Pricing is due June 9th.
- Glenforest at Brookreen Drive – A small wall will be constructed. Pricing is due June 23rd.
- Dunwoody Club Drive at Brookeridge Drive – The City of Dunwoody is replacing a storm pipe. The project is scheduled to start construction June 10th, weather permitting.

Environmental Court was held on June 3, 2016: Twenty-five defendants were scheduled to appear in court charged with 60 code violations. Eight defendants with 16 charges were adjudicated with fines, probation, or jail time. Fourteen trees were ordered for removal. One defendant was ordered to spend six months in jail. Four defendants with six charges failed to appear. Twelve defendants with 38 charges were reset for future court dates.

COMMUNITY APPEARANCE

- There were 49 signs removed from the City's rights-of-way during daily sign sweeps.
- Field Services crews completed 378 work orders:
 - Nine – Trim vegetation, debris pickup, dead animal removal
 - 252 – Trash pick-up from various rights-of-way throughout the city
 - 110 – Trash pick-up from SR 400 and I-285 and nine signs
 - Seven – General maintenance work orders were completed last week.

City Council and the Mayor were briefed about background data and assumptions. The recommendations will come in late summer.

Code Changes

- Community Development staff will be bringing forward several code changes for City Council review and discussion in the next few weeks. These include changes to the Stormwater Code, new regulations for the development of infill lots, and regulations to govern the location and operation of small distilleries and breweries. Many of these were reviewed by the Planning

Commission in April and went to the Mayor and Council for a vote in May. Most were approved, but some work remains on the small distilleries and breweries change, and it will go to the Mayor and Council in June. Others will follow in subsequent months. Although there is an ongoing process to update the existing code in a comprehensive manner, these are changes deemed necessary now. They will be incorporated into the new code.
