

PUBLIC SAFETY

SSPD

North District

- Crime:
 - Three bottles of vodka were taken after a white male threw a rock through the glass front window and made entry in the Beverage Store on Roswell Road. The incident was captured on video.
 - A woman left her apartment front door unlocked, due to not having a key. When she returned home, she saw a friend of her roommate inside of the apartment. After he had left the apartment, the victim noticed some clothing had been taken.
 - A woman called 911 because she saw a black male, holding a gun, jump over her locked fence and attempt to make entry into her home through the back door. The suspect was scared off by the victim. The victim advised officers that the suspect fled the Cardigan Circle complex in a white BMW. The Street Crimes Unit happened to be in the area and spotted the vehicle, detaining the suspect without incident. The suspect was positively identified and also admitted to slicing the tires of the victim's vehicle.
 - Forced entry on a home on Northridge Road with a large sum of money (more than \$10,000) stolen along with other items. Suspects were seen and described as a black male and a white male.
 - There were several burglaries that occurred in the 6800 block of Glenridge Drive. Entry was made through the rear doors. One suspect was described as a black male, 18-25 years of age, about five foot seven inches tall, clean shaven with afro-style hair, wearing a black baseball cap turned backwards.
 - Several burglaries occurred in the 6900 block of Roswell Road. Entry in those burglaries have been through unsecured windows.
 - An incident was reported on Pride Place in which the victims traveled to Sandy Springs to sell a Rolex watch to someone using the "Let Go" app. Upon arrival, three black males jumped out of a white Jeep (possibly a Liberty), with AK-47-type rifles. One suspect was wearing a ski mask. The victim immediately drove off and reported hearing a possible shot fired (but not loud like a normal rifle) and something striking his car. No damage was observed, and it is suspected the rifles were airsoft. No injuries were reported, and no loss of property recorded.
- Community:
 - Several Citizen Response to Active Shooter Event classes were given throughout the week.

South District

- Promotions:
 - Newly promoted Sergeant Joe Simone joins the South District as the South Evening Watch B Squad Sergeant. Sergeant Simone has represented SSPD for the past several years on several task force units, most notably the DEA Task Force.
 - South District Community Sergeant Forrest Bohannon moves to a new position as Community Affairs Sergeant and Public Information Officer (PIO). Sergeant Sam Worsham takes over Bohannon's District position after serving as the South Relief Sergeant.

- Sergeant Andrew Rausch will move from South Evening Watch B Squad Sergeant to the Relief Sergeant position.
- New officers joining the South District are Blake Zimmerman, joining SSPD from Hiram PD, Officer Gary Morgan from DeKalb County PD, Officer Alton Jackson and Jeremy Barton from APD, and Officer Joshua Brown from Gwinnett County PD.
- Crime:
 - One man was arrested inside a residence on Indian Trail after SSPD received a call from the residents of the home. The man told the residents that he used to live in the house and asked to spend the night. Officers arrived while the man waited in the driveway. The intruder was not suspected of attempting to burglarize the home and was believed to be in need of a medical evaluation. He was charged with Criminal Trespass and was taken to Northside Hospital for a medical evaluation prior to his transport to the Fulton County Jail.
- South District Community Officer Begeal met with several City Walk store managers and owners regarding recent complaints of a homeless man loitering in the area. Begeal reported that most of the merchants were familiar with the individual, and said they were not aggravated by his presence. One store manager told Begeal that the man pays for his meal and is courteous. Patrol officers will continue to monitor the area.

Street Crimes Unit (SCU)

- The Unit made two felony arrests, three misdemeanor arrests, conducted one traffic stop and issued one citation. The Unit located one wanted person, worked one drug complaint and issued four arrest warrants.
- Officers Snow and Silberberg initiated an investigation into an entering auto case related to a Pitts Road incident where the suspects attempted to use the victim's credit card at different locations in Sandy Springs.
- Officer Cannon arrested a subject for an outstanding disorderly conduct warrant while he assisted the Special Investigations Unit in a drug investigation at Harbor Pointe Pkwy.
- Officers Muehlenbrock and Snow obtained a tracker warrant for a vehicle believed to be involved in a recent entering auto case. The GPS tracker was placed on the car, and the investigation is ongoing.
- Officers Silberberg and Johnson responded to the burglary-in-progress call on Cardigan Circle noted in the North District report above.

Special Investigations Unit (SIU)

- SIU assisted Roswell Police Detectives related to a recent drive-by shooting in their jurisdiction. The follow-up included surveillance, assisting with interviews, developing leads and assisting with search warrants. Roswell was able to locate and take a suspect into custody, and the investigation is continuing.
- SIU assisted the SSPD K9 Unit with a large drug case investigation. A subject was found to be in possession of 1000 MDMA (Ecstasy) tablets and (50) Xanax pills (a controlled substance). SIU was able to obtain a search warrant for the residence in the Foxcroft Condominiums where an additional (6,616) prescribed medications and a small amount of cocaine were seized. Two subjects eventually charged with six total felonies.

Traffic Unit

- The Unit made two misdemeanor arrests, two DUI arrests, conducted 180 traffic stops and issued 218 citations. The Unit spent 56 hours working traffic complaints, 36 hours assisting other units, and conducted one call out.
- TRV 1 worked 12 crash calls, 22 patrol assists, and changed 13 flat tires. They dispensed nine gallons of gasoline, worked 84 self-initiated calls, and logged 948 miles on the road.

- Officer Millholland was a DUI Traffic Stop judge during the Explorer's competition at the Georgia Public Safety Training Center.
- Members of the Unit participated in Quick Response Force training.
- Several members of the Traffic Unit participated in a weekend enforcement detail on GA HWY 400 and I-285. While on the detail, members assisted on a call where the motorist had a projectile impale her neck after the object went through her windshield. The victim sustained a serious, but non-life threatening injury.

K9 Unit

- The Unit make two felony arrests, five city ordinance arrests, 27 traffic stops, and issued 25 citations. The Unit made three suspicious person/vehicle stops, conducted eight K9 searches, and worked eight drug complaints. The Unit conducted five knock and talk investigations, issued three search warrants, and spent 30 hours assisting other units. The Unit seized: .5 grams of heroin, .4 grams of cocaine, 78 Xanax pills, and 6,700 assorted pills.
- Officer deployed K9 Renzo on a traffic stop. The K9 alerted and marijuana was seized resulting in the motorist's arrest.
- Officer assisted with surveillance at Pep Boys of a female who was suspected of possessing heroin. The suspect left in a vehicle and was ultimately stopped by Officer. A K9 alert by "Django" resulted in the seizure of several baggies with heroin residue.
- Officers assisted USPS with a DEA target parcel track in which K9 "Rock" alerted, a federal search warrant was obtained, and a suspect was apprehended. A search warrant was also conducted at a Sandy Springs apartment where large amounts of illegal drugs were seized. As a result, a major multi-state MDMA/Xanax operation was shut down.

Criminal Investigations Division

- Home Invasion-Sandalwood Drive: The victim was interviewed by Narcotics and CID investigators, and information revealed the robbery was set up to rob one of the victims who made it known he was in the market to buy a large sum of marijuana. Roswell PD also interviewed a person wanted for aggravated assault, who provided police with the names of the suspects who committed the Sandy Springs home invasion. Suspects in the two investigations explained to investigators the incidents were part of an ongoing feud between the Bloods and Crips in North Fulton.
- Aggravated Stalking - Oak Bluff Drive: A felony warrant for Aggravated Stalking was secured for the arrest of Marre Woston who violated a consensual permanent protective order and began texting the victim again in June. She is a suspect in an email fraud/computer trespassing case against her ex-husband and has been indirectly threatening two Fulton County Superior Court judges via social media sites. The courts and the Sheriff's office were made aware of these threats.
- Road Rage/Disorderly Conduct- I-285 West at GA. 400: Detectives interviewed the victim and reviewed video footage. Investigators were able to transpose some letters and identified the suspect vehicle as well as the suspect. The suspect brandished a gun during this incident. The victim is pressing charges, and the suspect is being cooperative. The suspect was issued a citation for disorderly conduct.
- Aggravated assault- Roswell Road: Detectives met with management at Tony's Sports B and reviewed more than two hours of video footage related to a pistol whipping incident at the location. The camera that should have captured the pistol whipping was missing the recording. The only camera that captured footage shows the victim staggering back in holding his head. The victim is not cooperating. There are no additional leads in this case.
- DeKalb Police recovered a vehicle stolen from the victim's garage on Alderwood Lane. Inside the car was a receipt with a customer's name. Investigators discovered the same name was listed in

a Dunwoody motor vehicle theft incident. Dunwoody Detectives advised SSPD that they obtained the suspect's name from the cell phone left behind in the stolen vehicle in the Dunwoody case. SSPD and Dunwoody officers are now working together to link the cases and obtain warrants.

- Detectives obtained an arrest warrant based on phone records related to an entering auto case at Rays on the River. SSPD investigators also spoke with the Fulton County Gang Unit Investigator who is working on obtaining warrants on the same suspect related to gang charges. The investigation continues.

Community Affairs

- SSPD and Communications are working on enhancements for the SSPD area of the website.

Volunteers: Citizens on Patrol

- The Citizens on Patrol Unit worked 253 hours and conducted 41 shifts this past week. They conducted 32 house checks and issued 14 handicap parking citations.
- The Unit covered 1,088 miles on patrol.

SSFR

OPERATIONS

- Responded to a total of 234 calls: seven Fires, 84 EMS calls, 40 Service Calls, 76 Good Intent Calls, 21 False Alarms
- Crews provided medical coverage at the International Yoga Day at Hammond Park.
- Crews responded to reported structure fire at an apartment complex in the 6500 block of Roswell Road. Light smoke was reported upon arrival. A neighbor had used a garden hose to extinguish most of the fire, with the main area of fire damage appearing on the exterior of the structure. Crews removed the melted vinyl siding and checked for any possible hot spots. An investigation into the cause found that a smoker's bucket outside the home had caught fire and spread to some mulch located under some bushes. The fire or heat from the brush fire then melted the vinyl siding.
- Crews responded to reports of a smoking electrical outlet in the 900 block of Heard's Ferry Road. Crews arrived on scene, but could not gain access to the entry gate. After gaining access through the guest house, crews found a smoking electrical outlet and turned off the main power. The Thermal Imaging Camera showed a temperature of 137 degrees, with the reading lowering to 107 after ten minutes. Personnel advised the homeowner to contact an electrician.
- Crews were dispatched to I-285 Eastbound just before the Riverside Drive exit related to reports of a vehicle fire. Crews arrived to find a tractor trailer containing garbage, with smoke coming from the top and edges of the vehicle. Crews proceeded to put two roof ladders against the side of the tractor trailer to identify what was burning. Upon further investigation, the contents that were burning were unreachable. Since there was no fire showing at the time, personnel decided to have the tractor trailer relocate closer to a fire hydrant. Personnel connected to a fire hydrant on Mount Vernon Highway and used the aerial master stream to flood the tractor trailer.
- Crews responded to the report of a gas line struck by the power company in the 1000 block of Indian Trail. Crews arrived to find high pressure natural gas coming from a pipe on the side of a two lane residential road. Crews pulled a 1.75" line and connected the truck to a nearby hydrant. Personnel stood by with a charged hose line until the gas company was able to get a work crew on site to make the repair. Sandy Springs Police

Citizens On Patrol were also on scene to assist with traffic.

- Crews responded to the 9400 block of Roberts Drive on reports of a structure fire with a smell of smoke. Crews found light smoke coming from the first floor, with a working fire on a first floor apartment. Crews forced entry and extinguished the fire.
- Crews responded to a gas leak outdoors in the 6400 block of Cherry Tree Lane. Crews found a small leak coming from a line beside the driveway. Personnel blocked the street and stayed on-scene while Atlanta Gas Light repaired the line.

Inspections:

- There were 131 inspections conducted with 86 violations cited.

Training:

- Three TEMS members participated in training at the Cadaver Lab at the Emory School of Medicine.
- SSFR completed department-wide Stroke Recognition and Treatment Training.

Safety Education & Public Relations Events:

- Two Fire Safety Education events were held with 28 participants and two Station Tours.

Public Information:

- Medical Services Officer Flaherty was chosen as a member of a pilot federal response team for high risk events or gatherings. The 24-member team will deploy to events like Democratic and Republican National Conventions, UN General Assembly and the Presidential Inauguration.
- Deputy Chief Duke and Division Commander Willbanks attended the Traffic Incident Management seminar at the Georgia Public Safety Training Center.
- Community Affairs Officer Ware attended the Fire Safety Symposium at the Georgia Public Safety Training Center.

TRANSPORTATION

PROJECTS WITH MAJOR TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- July 2-3: Georgia Power will be removing lines from utility poles with a **lane closure in place at Sandy Springs Circle**. It will be a single lane closure, northbound, between Mt Vernon and Johnson Ferry Road.
- July 11 - 16: **Brandon Mill Road, between West Spalding Drive and Dunhill Court** will close to through traffic as Colonial Pipeline conducts maintenance work on a pipeline underneath Brandon Mill Road. Motorists traveling south on Brandon Mill are asked to detour down Dunhill Court to West Spalding to connect back to Brandon Mill. Those traveling north are asked to travel West Spalding to Dunhill Court. On site construction personnel will assist residents who live within the closure area to access their driveways. For information regarding the project, please contact Steve Baker with Colonial Pipeline at 678.762.2589.
- **Mt Vernon, between Sandy Springs Circle and Roswell Road**, remains closed as the road is widened and utility work takes place.
- Utility work will continue through July on Sandy Springs Circle. Please be watchful of crews working in the area, following directional signage and following construction speed limits - 25mph.

CIP

- T-8 Roswell Road Streetscape from Carpenter Drive to Hammond Drive: Construction continues with much of the construction activities occurring at night.
- T-33 CDBG Sidewalks: Concept plans are expected for review in the fall.
- Northridge Road Lighting: Work is projected to take place this summer to add pedestrian-scale street lighting on the north side of Northridge Road from Roswell Road to Dunwoody Place.
- T-34 Morgan Falls Road: Roadway repaving is scheduled for this summer, and a landscape project is planned for the fall/winter.
- T-43 Glenridge Drive at Roswell Road Intersection: The project preliminary plans are currently in review with GDOT.
- T-45 Windsor Parkway at Roswell Road Intersection Relocation: Roadway paving is complete with final work on the road shoulders occurring over the next month.
- T-46 **Carpenter Drive/Cliftwood Drive at Roswell Road** Intersection Improvement: **Construction is expected to begin next month.**
- Heards Ferry at Raider Drive Intersection Improvement: Overhead utility relocations are nearing completion, and water line relocations are forecasted to begin over the next few weeks.
- Powers Ferry at Heards Road Intersection Improvement: Utility relocations are nearing completion, and site grading is underway.
- FY2016 Sidewalk Program: Scoring is complete and the results were presented to Council for this year's Capital Sidewalk Program. Staff is working to begin the design process on the approved projects.
 - Brandon Mill from West Spalding to Marsh Creek Bridge Sidewalk: Construction bids are in review for installation of sidewalk on Brandon Mill from West Spalding to the Marsh Creek Bridge.
 - Glenridge Drive at Greenland Sidewalk: The construction project is being advertised for bids to extend existing sidewalk east to the intersection of Glenridge and Greenland on the south side of Glenridge Drive. Construction is planned for later this year.

- R-15133 IISNS Maintenance: Work Order issued to Siemens add illuminated street name signs at Roswell and Abernathy.
- T-7178 Dunwoody Club @ Jett Ferry: Staff is reviewing the scope for this project to restripe and add signage to address undersized intersection and safety.
- T-0044 ATMS 2 Project: Resolution approving the contract will be sent to GDOT.

NATURAL RESOURCE PROTECTION

Stormwater

- There are 51 identified projects: two are under construction, two are under design, six in contract development, one in right-of-way/easement acquisition, four in technical review, 35 in scope development, and the remaining pending final invoice or inspection.
- Four new drainage work requests were received last week.
- Windsor Parkway Detention Pond : The project consists of a walled detention pond and associated improvements. Construction is scheduled to begin July 1st; weather permitting.
- Glenforest at Brookgreen Drive: A small wall will be constructed. Butch Thompson had the lowest price.
- 1644 Brandon Hall Drive: A headwall will be rebuilt, and a storm pipe and catch basin will be replaced. Pricing was due June 29th.

Environmental Court was held on June 17, 2016 - Fifteen defendants were scheduled to appear in court charged with 40 municipal code violations. Seven defendants with 16 charges were adjudicated with fines or probation. Four defendants with seven charges failed to appear, and four defendants with 17 charges were reset for future court dates.

ENFORCEMENT EFFORTS
