







# Appendix A - Data Sources and Calculations

## Occupation Data

EMSI occupation employment data are based on final EMSI industry data and final EMSI staffing patterns. Wage estimates are based on Occupational Employment Statistics (QCEW and Non-QCEW Employees classes of worker) and the American Community Survey (Self-Employed and Extended Proprietors). Occupational wage estimates also affected by county-level EMSI earnings by industry.

## State Data Sources

This report uses state data from the following agencies: Georgia Department of Labor, Workforce Information and Analysis, Occupational Information Services Unit

## ZIP Code Data Disclaimer

Due to a lack of source data at the ZIP code level, EMSI's ZIP-level estimates can be less accurate when looking at a small number of ZIP codes. This is especially likely to occur in rural areas.
